Objectives

- To encourage and facilitate grazing for the benefit of wildlife, landscape and the cultural heritage of Wales.
- To maintain a strong relationship with and support GAP UK, and be incorporated into a UK-wide structure under the GAP UK umbrella.

- To act as a broker for information relevant to Wales, by gathering details of local grazing schemes, sharing best practice and making information available to those who require or request it.
- To inform, influence and guide opinion and policy within Wales and the United Kingdom.
- In co-operation with other organisations with compatible objectives, to seek to enhance conservation in Wales and minimise duplication of effort.

Structure, Governance and Management

Pori Natur a Threftadaeth was established in 2005 as a not for profit company. It was launched at the Royal Welsh Show in 2005 by the then Welsh Assembly Government Minister for Planning, Environment and Countryside. The Executive Council is made up of a Chairman, Vice-chairman, Secretary and Treasurer and no more than eight members. The Executive Council is elected by the Advisory Council, from members of the Advisory Council and is tasked by the Advisory Council to carry out the actions detailed in the PONT Work plan 2006-2009, which was approved by the PONT Advisory Council.

Activities

1. Support existing Welsh Local Grazing Schemes / 2. Help to establish new Welsh Local Grazing Schemes

Anglesey:

- Developed a stock leasing proposal based on a system developed by Natural England as part of the Limestone Country Project which was submitted for funding as a project for CCW grant aid, however state aid regulations preventing this being funded were insurmountable so the project was shelved.
- Continued meetings with CCW over the Anglesey and Lleyn Fens successful LIFE project.
- The 'Sustainable Grazing' project in Anglesey appointed a member of staff and was very successful in its first year with the end results of over 300 hectares of land under sustainable grazing management including 9 SSSI's and 3 non-statutory Wildlife Sites, with work in progress on 2 SSSI's and 7 Wildlife Sites and work planned on a further 3 SSSI's and 1 Wildlife Site.

Brecknock and Beacons Grazing Initiative:

- Involved in a group, led by the National Trust that also included the Welsh Commons Forum, the Brecon Beacons National Park Authority and the Countryside Council for Wales in developing a statement on the way forward for the Brecon Beacons.

Forgotten Landscapes Project:

- HLF funding was approved and PONT is continuing to work with the commons associations and other partners in its development year.

Valleys Regional Park LIFE+ Biodiversity Funding bid:

- Project group has been developed, made up of Caerphilly County Borough Council, Valleys Regional Park and PONT.
- A group from the Welsh Commons Forum has been briefed.
- Wales and West Utilities is offering £10,000 of funding toward the project development phase and the associated costs. This money can be used to match fund a CCW grant for a PONT Support Officer, who has been recruited and is working on this project
- PONT and a representative from the Valleys Regional Park has met with John Westlake from WAG's Axis 2 team, and he thought such a project could be part of an Axis 2 pilot area.

National Botanic Gardens / Carmarthenshire:

- PONT is working with the Grasslands Trust (Carmel NNR), MoD & IBERS (Pendine), Camarthenshire County Council (Pembrey) and the National Botanic Garden of Wales to submit a WREN Bid in January 2010 to secure improved grazing management of these sites.

Pembrokeshire Coast Grazing Network:

- A Pembrokeshire LGS network meeting was attended and a PONT update and a brief on the possibility for funding under the Enhancement of Grassland funding was given.
- The PONT Coordinator also undertook site visits with the Ynys Mon LGS Coordinator, to learn from Pembrokeshire's existing best practice.

NT Penrhyn Mawr

- PONT was involved in working with the National Trust, RSPB and CCW, to develop a newly tenanted farm as a potential hub for delivering grazing for wildlife for statutory and other sites on the Llyn Peninsula. This involved PONT helping with the interviews for the future tenant, inputting into the vision for the site.

Site based work and visits:

1. **Patrick Sankey Barker** - Attended a site meeting and arranged grazing for his site.
2. **Quentin McGarvey** - Attended a meeting on site at his farm to look at grazing issues, hoping he may apply to the Enhancement of Grassland pot to help solve them, but this did not occur.
3. **Lleust Pony Trust** - Attended a meeting on site to look at grazing issues, hoping they may apply to the Enhancement of Grassland pot to help solve them.
4. **Caerphilly County Borough Council** - Attended site meetings with one of the CCBC Commons Rangers and one of their other rangers to look at solutions to some grazing issues that were present.
5. **Llantrisant Town Trust** - Attended a meeting with members of the Trust, RCT Council and CCW to look at grazing issues over Llantrisant and the Graig Commons SSSI's. This has led to the Trust receiving Enhancement of Grassland funding for site line clearance on the commons and to put reflective collars on ponies and cattle.
6. **Garn Lakes** - Working with Torfaen County Borough Council to try to achieve pony and / cattle grazing on this site for wet rough grassland in one area and for Lapwing on the other.
7. **Harlech** - Contacted by CCW to work with the Golf Course to deliver grazing for wildlife.
8. **Island Fields** - Contacted about ideas on how to try to deliver grazing for wildlife benefit on this site and suggestions were made.
9. **Llanfair Cerieinion** - Worked with the Hill Pony Improvement Societies of Wales and site owner to try to deliver grazing for wildlife benefit on this 4 acre site.
10. **Resolven** - Contacted by the Environment Agency to try to deliver grazing for wildlife on this 30 acre area, but waiting for the legal aspects of the site acquisition prior to becoming more involved.
11. **Ty Mawr** - Working with the owners and the BBNPA to take forward sustainable grazing management on this area.
12. **The Brynna** - Worked with the Hill Pony Improvement Societies of Wales to try to deliver grazing for wildlife benefit on this 1.5 acre site for the Woodland Trust.
13. **Brecon Beacons National Park** - Attended a site meeting and gave some advice on a potential Sec109 agreement due to be developed by the planning dept of the Brecon Beacons National Park Authority.
14. **Bryn Alyn SSSI** – grant aided infrastructure via the Enhancement of Grassland Funding Stream.
15. **Bryn Euryn SSSI** – Via the Ynys Mon LGS Coordinator, PONT is working with the local authority to try to develop grazing on the site.
16. **Mynydd Craig and Mynydd Penarfynydd** - Have been in communication with NT and RSPB over this site and possibly hoping to grant aid work.
17. **Alun Valley** - Grant aiding Butterfly Conservation to put in a pony coral via the Enhancement of Grassland Funding Stream, and have linked BC with a potential pony grazier.
18. **Caerwent** – Working with CCW and the MoD to secure cattle grazing for site, having already found a pony grazier.
19. **Cors Ian** – Grant aided infrastructure via the Enhancement of Grassland Funding Stream.
20. **Penllwyn Grassland SSSI** - Working with CCW and CBBC to try to develop a grant bid to tackle the infrastructure problems of the site.
21. **Tir Gofal** – Was asked for advice on upland grazing for the Vivod Estate near Llangollen by the project officer.

3. Develop publicity by attending 3 relevant Wales-wide events annually to raise PONT's profile, network and inform the public

1. Had a display at the Exchange Fair at the UKBAP Conference in Cambridge.
2. Had a display at the Exchange Fair at the Wales Biodiversity Partnership Conference in Aberystwyth.
3. Attended and helped with the launch of the Anglesey Grazing Animals Project at Ynys Mon Show.

4. Facilitate a minimum of 3 field visits and/or meetings for interested parties every calendar year

5. Develop and maintain a bilingual PONT website

- PONT website running.

6. Improve communications between graziers, farmers and landowners

- The PONT section in GAP News ongoing.
- PONT Coordinator has contributed to GAP News 42, the final one prior to the end of GAP, and to an interim newsletter to cover the period before the Grazing Animals Partnership in England was formally launched in April 2009.
- The long version of the Conservation Grazing Characteristics of the semi-feral Section A Welsh Mountain Pony has been finished, a PDF is on the PONT website and 200 paper copies of the leaflet have been given to the Hill Pony Improvement Societies.
- Had a display, and sponsored the Native Cattle Breeds competition, at the RWAS Smallholders Show.

Information Gathering, Networking and Mainstreaming

The PONT Coordinator has:

1. Attended a Wales Biodiversity Partnership 'Policy Group' meeting and sits on the Wales Biodiversity Partnership's Policy, Upland, Wetland, Grassland and Heathland, and Farmland groups.
2. Gave a presentation on PONT and its work to the members of the Countryside Council for Wales's Council.
3. Attended a FWAG Cymru event and walk at Slade Farm.
4. Attended a day about LIFE+ Nature and LIFE+ Biodiversity in London.
5. Attended NATUR Executive and Membership Group meetings, when possible.
6. Attended a WPCS Equine Welfare Seminar at Gelli Aur.
7. Attended and gave a presentation at the CCW Lowlands Grassland Group meeting in Aberystwyth.
8. Inputted into the 'Saving our Magnificent Meadows' project by contributing to meetings via teleconferences and one meeting in person.
9. Attended an Usk to Wye Conference organised by Gwent Wildlife Trust.
10. Attended an upland hay meadows event in the Elan Valley.

7. Investigate and research ways in which improved levels of income can be generated by activities of client LGS projects.

- PONT was successful in getting funding from CCW to hold a daylong event based around marketing products from Nature Conservation and this was held on the 3rd March 2009 with 40+ attendees, organised by the PONT Support Officer; the output will be on the PONT website.

8. Assess constraints of Welsh graziers and landowners in achieving favourable grazing regimes on sites of wildlife and landscape importance and attempt to reduce or eliminate these over time.

- Working with members of the Wetland and Grassland and Heathland ecosystem Groups, PONT is developing a project – the West Wales Grazing Animals Scheme to implement sustainable grazing management over statutorily, and non statutorily protected grassland, heathland and peatland sites in the CCW Western region. This has involved numerous meetings and linking with the Wales Biodiversity Partnership, CCW Western region and others. This is likely to lead to a funding bid during 2011.
- PONT via the Wales Biodiversity Partnership has been continually involved in inputting into GlasTir consultations.
- Attended and gave a presentation at a CCW organised Outcome 21 day.

9. To support the development of GAP UK

- Attended the final GAP (Grazing Animals Project) Advisory Council meeting.

- PONT maintained communication with the GAP staff until they left, and since then with the Grazing Animals Partnership lead officer in England.

10. Employ a PONT co-ordinator officer, initially for three years, to lead on developing and establishing new local grazing schemes in Wales

- The initial three year grant from CCW finished, and as PONT delivered the outcomes required, it has been successful in obtaining funding for a further year.
- PONT has been successful in a bid developed by the PONT Chairman and CCW's internal PONT Project supervisor, to part fund a Support Officer.
- The success of a bid by CCW's Lowland Grassland Network Officer to fund a project totalling approx £30,000 over three years, to put into infrastructure to facilitate long term sustainable grazing has led to grants being made to a wide range of individuals (Enhancement of Grassland Scheme).

11. Supporting Welsh Indigenous Breeds

- PONT worked with representatives of the Welsh Pony and Cob Society, the Hill Ponies of Wales Improvement Societies and the Cymdeithas Merlod y Carneddau Cyf to develop successful derogations from the Welsh Assembly Government, so as to negate the need for microchipping of some semi-feral foals under the new equine regulations from Europe that came into force on 1st July 2009.

Sefydlwyd Pori Natur a Threftadaeth yn 2005 fel cwmni dielw. Fe'i lanswyd yn Sioe Frenhinol Cymru yn 2005 gan Weinidog Llywodraeth Cynulliad Cymru dros Gynllunio, yr Amgylchedd a Chefn Gwlad ar y pryd. Mae'r Cyngor Gweithredol yn cynnwys Cadeirydd, Is-gadeirydd, Ysgrifennydd a Thrysorydd ac wyth aelod ar y mwyaf. Etholir y Cyngor Gweithredol gan y Cyngor Ymgynghorol, o blith aelodau'r Cyngor Ymgynghorol, ac mae'n cael tasgau gan y Cyngor Ymgynghorol i gymryd y camau a ddisgrifir yng Nghynllun Gwaith PONT 2006-2009, a gymeradwywyd gan Gyngor Ymgynghorol PONT.

1. Cefnogi Cynlluniau Pori Lleol presennol Cymru/ 2. Helpu i sefydlu Cynlluniau Pori Lleol newydd yng Nghymru

Ynys Môn:

- Wedi datblygu cynnig prydlesu stoc sy'n seiliedig ar system a ddatblygwyd gan Natural England yn rhan o Limestone Country Project, a gyflwynwyd am gyllid fel prosiect ar gyfer cymorth grant CCGC; fodd bynnag, roedd y rheoliadau cymorth gwladwriaethol a oedd yn atal hwn rhag cael ei ariannu yn anorchfygol felly cafodd y prosiect ei ohirio.
- Cyfarfodydd parhaus â CCGC ynghylch prosiect LIFE llwyddiannus Ffeniau Ynys Môn a Llŷn.
- Penododd y prosiect 'Pori Cynaliadwy' yn Ynys Môn aelod o staff ac roedd yn llwyddiannus iawn yn ei flwyddyn gyntaf a'r canlyniad oedd bod mwy na 300 hectar o dir dan reolaeth pori cynaliadwy gan gynnwys 9 SoDdGA a 3 Safle Bywyd Gwyllt anstatudol, gyda gwaith wedi dechrau ar 2 SoDdGA a 7 Safle Bywyd Gwyllt a gwaith ar y gweill ar 3 SoDdGA ac 1 Safle Bywyd Gwyllt pellach.
